To set up your legacy gift, contact your lawyer and ask them to create a new will or add a codicil (amendment) to your existing will.

You can either determine your gift as a percentage of your estate, or as a specific amount, by using this sample wording:

"I give to SeedChange (charity registration number #11927-6129-RR-0001), currently located at 56 Sparks Street, Suite 600, Ottawa, Ontario, _____% of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate to be used for its general charitable purposes."

or

"I give to SeedChange (charity registration number #11927-6129-RR-0001), currently located at 56 Sparks Street, Suite 600, Ottawa, Ontario, the sum of \$_____ to be used in support of its general charitable purposes."
